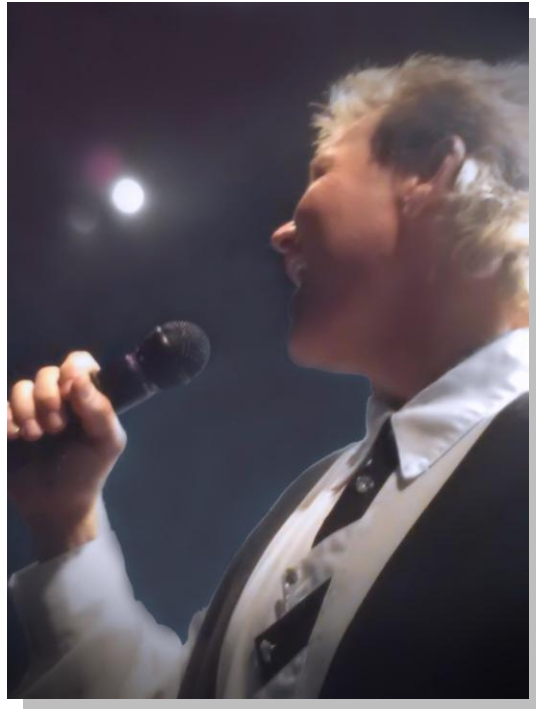


About Danny Riddle

Danny hosted the show for over eleven years and was syndicated across the country during the 80's and 90's, the show featured local talent as well as nationally known Christian performers.

There are several singles that Danny has released, including the heartfelt "Two Hearts in Love." All proceeds from that single goes to the Alzheimer's Foundation of America. Written by Micki Fuhrman, it chronicles the heartbreak of dementia but also offers hope.
